


## **ASPAC 2024 Convention Tours**

Hi Everyone,

Unfortunately due to the number of activities occurring during Convention week and the weekend, due to the Festival Fringe and WOMAD, there are only a limited number of tours with limited seating.

**Tour 1** is a Pre-Convention tour Wednesday the 6<sup>th</sup> of March starting from the InterContinental Hotel. Start time is 9.30am. From Adelaide to the Barossa Valley, visiting the Whispering Wall, a number of wonderful wineries and lunch at the Vine Inn. The cost of this tour is A\$60 which includes the lunch (drinks at your own expense). The tour is limited to the first 22 people to book.

You should be back at the InterContinental Hotel about 4.30pm.

**Tour 2** is being held on Thursday the 7<sup>th</sup> of March – with extra seats available for the Executive Board Partners Tour. Start time is 9.30am outside of the Adelaide Railway Station Tram Stop. Heading to seaside suburb of Glenelg by an Adelaide Tram. Take a brief stroll around Glenelg, buy some souvenirs before heading to Wigley Reserve to enjoy a BBQ luncheon on the grass.

After lunch you will be taken by bus to Dunluce Castle for afternoon tea and a history of Dunluce Castle, Brighton and Glenelg. After the presentation you will farewell Dunluce Castle, board the Kiwanis Bus for your trip back to the Intercontinental Hotel by about 4.30pm. The cost of this tour is A\$30.

There are currently about a dozen vacant seats.

**Tour 3** is to the Southern Vales. Leaving at 10am from the outside of the InterContinental Hotel) at 10am, we head south away from the city CBD. Returning to the bus it will take you to the McLaren Vale Information Centre, where lunch (a number of shared tasting platters of local produce) has been pre-booked. Drinks are at your own expense. Take the time to browse through the souvenirs and the Art Gallery.

Time to take in the sights as you take a scenic drive along the beautiful coast to Port Noarlunga. Return to the InterContinental Hotel by about 3.30pm, with plenty of time to prepare for Saturday night's Farewell Dinner. The cost of this tour is \$40.
